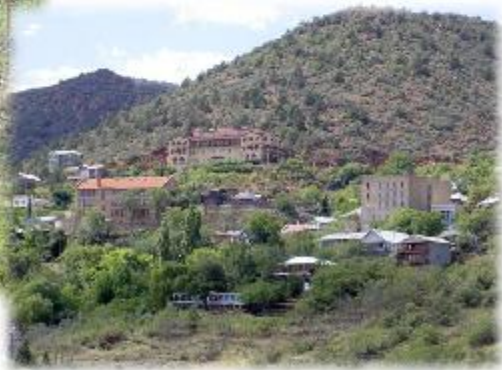
## **MOUNTAIN TOP STREET RODDERS**

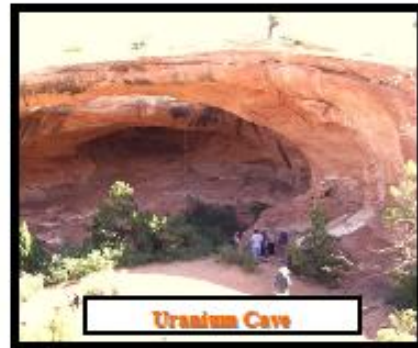
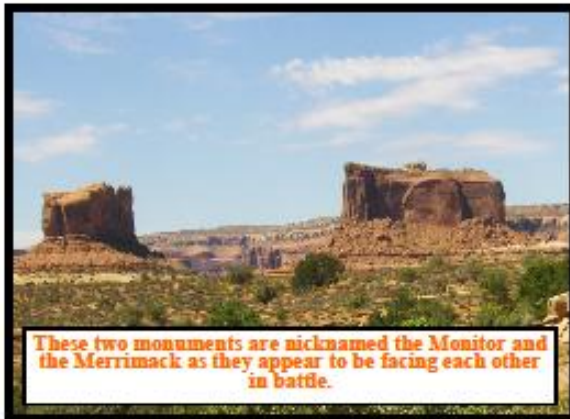


# LOU AND SAM'S MOAB ADVENTURE
